(Microsoft Certified Systems Engineer)

Program: Students are immersed in a comprehensive IT program, learning several operating systems, PC hardware, troubleshooting fundamentals and web design. Over 600 hours of instructor-led lab training simulates a real-world work environment and prepares the student for several certifications. A core program component is the Microsoft Certified System Engineer Module. Upon certification, students are capable of analyzing a company's IT requirements and implementing the infrastructure for business solutions.

Graduates may receive a College Diploma and are prepared to write Microsoft's MCSE, MCSA, MCTS and CompTia's A+ and Network + certification exams.
